1) Old Havana Tour

Guided walking tour of Old Havana, throughout its four main squares. Discover a city full of history, romance and mix of cultures and religions. Visit the City Museum and/or Havana Club Rum Museum during the day and early afternoon, or the Morro Castle Museum and its famous Canon Blast Ceremony in the late afternoon/early evening, according to your arrival time. Tour includes pick up at the airport, van for the day, entrance fees to museums, English speaking guide, and one drink. Camera fees, lunch/dinner and tips are not included.



2) Havana Hemingway Tour

Visit Finca La Vigia, Ernest Hemingway's Cuban home from 1940 to 1960. Tour the house and grounds and view the Hemingway memorabilia. Next, visit the town of Cojimar stopping at a local restaurant for lunch then heading back to downtown Havana for drink at one of Hemingway's many watering holes. (El Floridita, La Bodeguita del Medio or Ambos Mundos Hotel's terrace). Tour includes a van for the day, an English-speaking guide, and one drink. Camera fees, lunch and tips are not included.

3) Art Tour

Curator guided tour of the Cuban Fine Arts Museum followed by lunch at a "paladar" (private restaurant) in Havana. In the afternoon, visit Cuban artist studios (recommended for Art collectors) and a promenade at Jose Fuster's neighborhood. Tour includes a van for the day, an English speaking guide, entrance to the museum, and one drink. Camera fees, lunch and tips are not included.

4) Modern Havana Tour in Vintage Convertible Cars

Visit Morro Castle for a special view of Havana City, Malecon, Vedado neighborhood, Havana Forest, Mirimar, and a final stop at world famous Nacional Hotel for a drink. Tour includes an English-speaking guide, cars and drivers for the tour and one drink.



5) Havana Architecture Tour

Experience Old Havana through an architect's eyes. Beginning from The Capitol, walk all the way down to Malecon with stops at architectural reference points such as the Great Havana Theater and Bacardi building. Stop for lunch, and continue in Vedado neighborhood. Witness the re-birthing first hand. Stop for refreshments. Tour includes an English speaking architecture lecturer, van, driver for the day, and one drink. Lunch and tips are not included.

6) Salsa Dancing Tour

Start with 90 min of salsa lessons in the afternoon with professional teachers, to learn the basic steps of Cuba's most popular rhythm. Take a break for a shower, dinner and, after catching your breath, get ready to meet your salsa teachers at a night club to enjoy and improve your dancing skills! Tour includes van and driver all afternoon/night, multilingual guide, salsa lessons and club entrance. Dinner, drinks and tips not included.

7) Vinales Town Cigar, UNESCO World Heritage Cultural Landscape, and Organic Farm to Table Lunch Tour

This full-day tour includes several wonderful stops. Travel through the Cuban countryside to the quaint, colorful town of Viñales, near Pinar del Rio, the world's best cigar tobacco growing region. Visit a local farmer's tobacco plantation and his tobacco drying house where you will enjoy a cigar rolling demonstration. (Optional horseback riding tour of the area available for an additional fee.) Visit El Mural de la Prehistoria,



La Cueva del Indio (the Indian cave), an unforgettable underground river tour inside the mountain. Enjoy lunch at La Finca el Paraiso, a family owned organic farm to table eatery. Tour includes English speaking guide, van and driver for the day, entrance fees and lunch. Camera fees, drinks and tips not included.

8) Varadero Beach Day Tour

Take a two hour drive east and you'll find yourself at a picture perfect Cuban beach. Located in one of the world's best resorts, this beach features 22 km of white powder-fine sand and crystal clear water. It is undoubtedly the perfect stress-free place and one of the top places to enjoy fresh lobster and seafood on the island. Optional stops on the way at Saturno's Cave, a subterranean cave with an indoors natural pool, or "The Coral Reef beach" for the snorkeling/diving enthusiastic. Tour includes van and driver for the day, entrance fees to Saturno's Cave or The Coral Reef, multilingual guide and one drink. Lunch, snorkeling gear and tips are not include.
